Training and Technical Assistance Resources for PCHP Awardees

The training and technical assistance (T/TA) resources listed below were developed by BPHC-supported T/TA Partners and curated by BPHC to address the following top four TA areas requested in the FY 2021 PCHP applications. Also included are links to <u>more general BPHC-supported and Federal EHE resources</u>.

Top Four Requested TA areas:

- 1. <u>Supporting the use of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP), including prescribing, the use of prescription assistance programs, and PrEP navigators</u>
 - Requested by 59 health centers or 54.63% of funded 2021 awardees.
- Performing HIV prevention outreach to new patients and in-reach to existing patients
 Requested by 48 health centers or 44.44% of funded 2021 awardees.
- 3. Using electronic health record data and health information technology enhancements to facilitate HIV prevention and clinical decision support
 - Requested by 42 health centers or 38.89% of funded 2021 awardees.
- 4. Telehealth in HIV prevention and treatment, including tele-PrEP
 - Requested by 41 health centers or 37.96% of funded 2021 awardees.
