

A Snapshot of Participating Health Centers, 2021-2022*

As the National Resource Center (NRC) for Health Center Training and Technical Assistance (TTA), NACHC convenes a diverse advisory group of HRSA-funded TTA Partners including National TTA Partners (NTTAPs), Primary Care Associations (PCAs), and Health Center Controlled Networks (HCCNs). The mission of the advisory group is to advance health center operations and patient outcomes through a coordinated approach to training and technical assistance.

Learning collaboratives (LCs) are a specially designed training series by an NTTAP or groups of NTTAPs. An LC describes a cohort of health center staff who gathers for a series of four or more educational sessions. These sessions foster peer networking and learning communities in which learners gain and apply knowledge and share their health center experiences in specific topic areas. LCs address a variety of topics to support health center operational, fiscal, and clinical improvements.

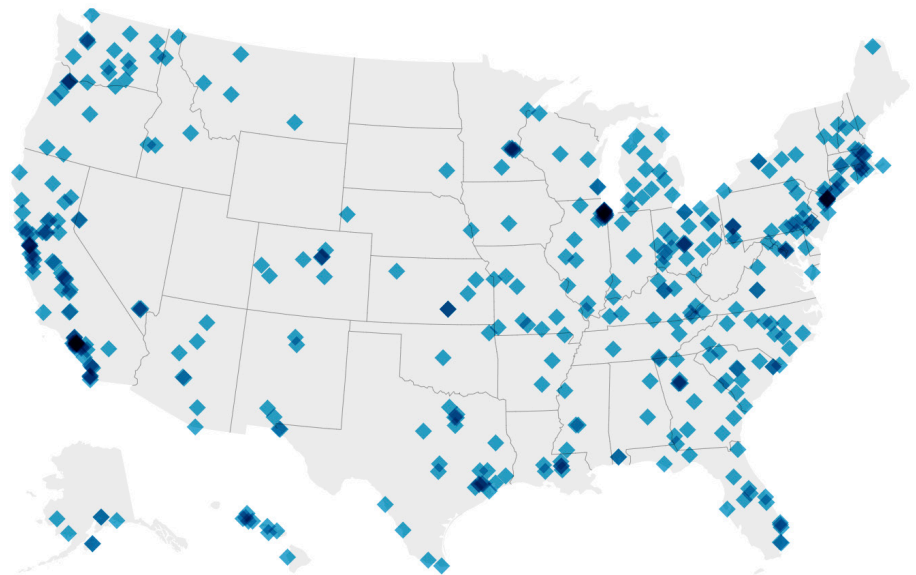
During 2021-2022, NTTAPs engaged over 2,200

Locations of health centers participating in LCs during 2021-2022.



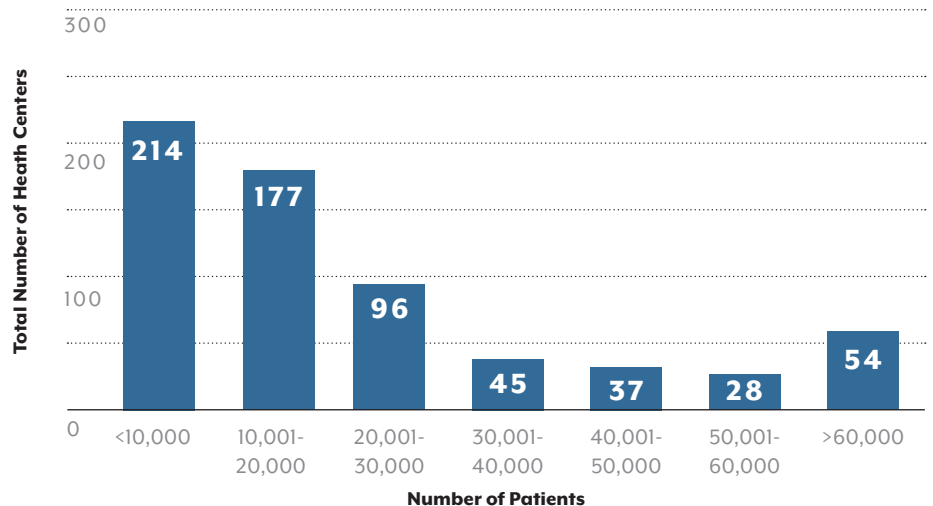
